A NOTE FROM PASTOR JANE

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Lenten journey is often filled with heartfelt prayer and contemplation that, hopefully, ends with a sense of healing and a good dose of amazement at the love of our Savior. We've spent 40 days following Jesus and his disciples, witnessing miracles, and coming face-to-face with mortality.

But, in return, we have witnessed in triumph, the Son of Man ride into Jerusalem amidst cries of Hosannah!

We have seen the righteous anger of the Son of God as Jesus entered the temple and overturned the tables of the money changers who dared to disgrace his father's house.

We watched in curiosity as the One who is called Healer and Rabbi washed the feet of those who did not comprehend who He is. We are amazed as the Prophet broke bread and drank from the cup with his disciples one last time.

We have agonized as Jesus was betrayed by a beloved friend for thirty pieces of silver and taken prisoner. We cringed as he was put through an unfair trial for daring to oppose the ones in authority by showing love and compassion for others, ALL others.

We have seen Peter, the Rock, deny his Lord, not once, not twice, but three times. We have pondered the injustice with Pilate. We flinched as the Messiah was flogged, beaten, humiliated, spat upon, and defiled; as he carried his own cross up to Golgotha, the place of the skull where he screamed, writhing in pain.

We have mourned with his mother, Mary, as she watched from afar, broken, and unable to protect Emmanuel, God with us.

We have averted our eyes as spikes were driven through his flesh and bones, causing such intense pain that would bring most humans to death.

Then, we too felt the forgiveness in our hearts as the Bread of Life offers that same forgiveness and a place in paradise to two common thieves.

We have strained to hear the Good Shepherd, whose voice we know so well, as he cried out with his last breath, begging his father to forgive his tormentors.

We mourned as the Only Begotten Son's body was taken down from the cross and lain in a tomb meant for another; even as the entrance is sealed with a stone. We waited for three days in darkness, caught up in our doubts, wondering if all that he said and did was real.

And, finally, finally, we marveled in the mystery of the One who was dead, but now lives.

Now, we can breathe again as we have come through the darkness and into the light of Easter. We are an Easter people, living in a world filled with hate. So, how do we strive for joy, how do we continue to seek healing from our God?

We continue to love God and love others. We love our neighbors as ourselves. We talk to God, and we continue that relationship. We ask God for grace. We look to our Savior as the example.


