

A NOTE FROM PASTOR JANE

Dear Friends in Christ,

If you know me at all, you probably know that I'm an extrovert. I like people. I can walk into a room and make friends with just about anyone. But, when I'm in a group of people, I sometimes get the urge to say, "OK. Talk amongst yourselves." It's not that I'm feeling anti-social or I'm upset. I just like to hear people's stories.

Pastor Ed Dobson, in his video series, "Ed's Story," shares the wisdom that sometimes being with others involves simply practicing "show up and shut up" ministry. Sometimes just being present can bring more comfort, peace, and a sense of God's presence than words ever could. That just makes sense to me.
