A NOTE FROM PASTOR JANE

Colossians 2:6-7 (NRSV)

⁶ As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, continue to walk in him, ⁷ rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.

Dear Friends in Christ,

The verse above is my favorite Bible verse. I was introduced to it around 1984 by my friend Mary at Bible Camp. It has been a reminder of who I am and whose I am in times of trouble and in times of joy. I share these words with you as a reminder that, no matter what, we are all children of God; beloved; perfect as we are; created for a purpose.

Throughout the summer, a small group of us has been studying Martin Luther's teachings from the Small Catechism. As we begin the school year, I have been contemplating Confirmation classes – we, too, will be focusing on the Small Catechism and the teachings of Jesus. Getting back to our roots. I find myself going dwelling in the verse from Paul's letter to the church at Colosse and Laodicea.

"Paul had never visited Colosse. Evidently Epaphras and other converts from Paul's missionary travels had founded the church. The church, however, had been infiltrated by religious relativism with some believers attempting to combine elements of heathenism and secular philosophy with Christian doctrine. Writing from Rome, where he was imprisoned, Paul confronted these false teachings and affirmed the sufficiency of Christ." ¹

Some of this should sound familiar. Some things never change.

So, what does this have to do with those of us who attend Faith Lutheran Church in Columbus, WI almost 2,000 years later?

Well, there are a lot of things in this world that would have us turn away from our faith. Money, politics, disagreements, other interests ... But we must be reminded that our roots are in Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. We must be reminded that we together we are built up in Christ and have established our faith. But, perhaps the most difficult part of this verse is abounding in thanksgiving.


